



SPONSOR INFORMATION

Candidate Selection

Those who are about to sponsor a candidate for a Cursillo must be aware of the task to which we are committing ourselves and of the **seriousness of our action. First Action PRAYER.**

Requirements and Guidelines

1. The candidate has the potential to be a leader and is capable of acting as an evangelical leaven in his/her environments.
2. You should know this person intimately. They should be your friend of whom you have shared many conversations about your faith.
3. The candidate must be 21 years of age or older and mature enough to assimilate the evangelical message and commit to it.
4. The candidate should be a Catholic (not necessarily practicing) and able to receive the Sacraments. If they are thinking of converting – contact the Archdiocesan Sprigtail Director and have a conversation with him prior to inviting your friend.
5. There must exist the opportunity for follow-up and support of the Cursillista by the Cursillo community through group reunion and Ultreya. **(Remember: The main job of the sponsor begins after the candidate has attended the Cursillo weekend.)**
6. The candidate should not be under any unusual stress. (Out of respect for the candidate and in courtesy to other attendees as well, the Cursillo weekend is not to be used as a "cure" for marital or emotional problems, substance abuse, etc. Doing so incurs the risk of causing more harm than good.)
7. The candidate should be approached about the possibilities of all available dates for the year. Applications are processed on a first come basis and potentially they may be placed on a waiting list.
8. Make sure you and your candidate are free for the dates of the weekend as well as the Teaching Ultreya. The sponsor must be available to support the candidate before during and after the weekend.

Candidate Preparation

1. Pray before approaching your friend to invite them to be apart of the 3-Day weekend.
2. Do not be secretive. Answer honestly any questions the candidate has about the movement or the weekend (with the exception of palanca and the Candlelight).
3. Explain that Cursillo is a community with follow up activities to support them after the weekend. (Group Reunion and Ultreya). You may even want to invite them to attend an Ultreya. Remember you do not have to make a weekend to attend Reunion or Ultreya.
4. If possible, explain Cursillo to both husband and wife together.

Candidate Preparation

1. **Submit completed Candidate's Form and Sponsor's Commitment (including pastor's approval, if deemed necessary) to the Pre-Cursillo Chair.**
2. If you cannot personally bring your candidate to the Cursillo weekend, arrange transportation. Candidates should not drive to the Cursillo site alone.
3. **Do palanca for your candidate and write a general and/or personal palanca note. It also means to attend the Sponsor Liturgy on Thursday.**
4. Provide assistance to your candidate's family as needed throughout the weekend.
5. Attend the Clausura and take your candidate home. (Notify candidate and spouse of approximate time of return on Sunday evening.)
6. **After the weekend, help your candidate find a permanent group reunion.**
7. Encourage your candidate to become a member of the Cursillo community by accompanying him/her to Ultreya for the first 12 months.

WHAT IS CURSILLO?

Cursillo is a Christian movement recognized by the Roman Catholic Church (and which has subsequently spread to several other Christian churches). It began in Spain in 1949 and was started by Bishop Juan Hervas and Dr. Eduardo Bonin.

Its name comes from the Spanish word "Cursillo", which means "small course." The original, full name is "Cursillo de Cristiandad", meaning "short course in Christianity."

However, it is neither a theoretical course nor a traditional retreat; it is best described as an experience. It is an experience which leads to discovering a better life and what is fundamental in Christianity.

During the three days of the weekend, participants have a deep and profound experience of Christian life:

We get to know ourselves better (encounter self)

We experience the presence and love of Jesus Christ (encounter with Jesus)

We see the goodness that can be provided by a loving and caring Christian community (encounter with others)

The whole point of the Cursillo movement is that ordinary people can steadily grow in the love and service of God and man for the rest of their lives. The Cursillo weekend represents the first essential step along the way. Christian growth is a life-long process, and Cursillo provides a framework for it, both during the three days and afterwards in the post-Cursillo, where emphasis is on maintaining a vibrant and growing Christian community, from which springs the apostolic action required to make ours a better world in which to live.
